Resolution No. 02 – 2000

RESOLUTION INCLUDING THE PHILIPPINE CENTER ON TRANSNATIONAL CRIME (PCTC) IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERPOL NATIONAL CENTRAL BUREAU AND DESIGNATING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, PHILIPPINE CENTER ON TRANSNATIONAL CRIME AS HEAD, INTERPOL-NCB SECRETARIAT AND CHAIRMAN, NALECC SUB-COMMITTEE ON INTERPOL

WHEREAS, Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 92 dated February 15, 1993 designated the Philippine National Police as INTERPOL National Central Bureau (NCB) for the Republic of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Paragraph 7 of the above-mentioned circular provided the membership of the INTERPOL National Central Bureau (NCB) and that the Heads of other agencies as additional members shall be determined by the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 100 re “Strengthening the operational, administrative and information support system of the PCTC” dated May 7, 1999 and the C, PNP approved Memorandum from the Executive Director, PCTC re implementation of Executive Order No. 1000 dated February 7, 2000, the INTERPOL-NCB Secretariat was transferred from DPL, PNP to PCTC effective February 24, 2000;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Executive Director, PCTC be included in the membership of INTERPOL-NCB and is hereby designated Head, INTERPOL-NCB Secretariat, and Chairman, NALECC Sub-Committee on INTERPOL.
