RESOLUTION NO. 03-2001

EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE NALECC SUB-COMMITTEE ON ILLEGAL RECRUITMENT AND RENAMING IT AS SUB-COMMITTEE ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING

WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment is one of the functional Sub-Committee of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC);

WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment consists of the following agencies as members pursuant to the Resolution No. 99-04 which was unanimously approved by the body on May 28, 1999 during the 73rd NALECC Regular Meeting at the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas, Regional Office 11, Davao City:

WHEREAS, during the 91st NALECC Regular Meeting, Police Superintendent Danilo Constantino of the Philippine Center on Transnational Crime (PCTC) recommended the expansion of the Sub-Committee to cover all forms of Human Trafficking such as mail-order bride, child and sex trafficking, and suggested that the NALECC Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment be renamed as Sub-Committee on Human Trafficking;

WHEREAS, during the 92nd NALECC Regular on July 27, 2001, TDO and Head, Secretariat recommended the inclusion of the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) and the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) Police Force as members of the Sub-Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) and the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) Police Force be included as members of the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment, and renamed the same as Sub-Committee on Human Trafficking.
