### **Resolution No. 04 - 2002**

#### **RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE STAND OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD THAT THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) ADMITS AS VALID THE DRUG TEST RESULTS OF GOVERNMENT LABORATORIES FOR PURPOSES OF SECURING DRIVER'S LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC) was created by virtue of Executive Orders 829, 41 and 41-A;

WHEREAS, the NALECC is composed of forty-one (41) member agencies, with the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) as one of its active members;

WHEREAS, during the 99<sup>th</sup> NALECC Regular Meeting on July 26, 2002 held at the Main Clubhouse, Camp John Hay, Baguio City, Atty. Bernardo T Lastimoso, Executive Director of the Dangerous Drugs urged that the Land Transportation Office (LTO) admits as valid the drug test results of government laboratories, especially that of the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB), and the PNP Crime Laboratory, for purposes of securing driver's license.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that NALECC member-agencies strongly support the proposition of Executive Director Lastimoso.
