Resolution No. 09 - 2002

INCLUSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) AS REGULAR MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE (NALECC)

WHEREAS, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) is one of the primary government agencies created pursuant to Executive Order No. 192, series of 1987, responsible in the conservation, management, development and proper use of the country's environment and natural resources:
