**INCLUSION OF THE ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION (ERC) AS REGULAR
MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND COORDINATING
COMMITTEE (NALECC)**

WHEREAS, Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) is one of the primary government agencies created pursuant to Republic Act No. 9136 ordaining Reforms in the Philippine Electric Power Industry, otherwise known as the “Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001.”

WHEREAS, said agency is responsible in the conduct of audit and inspection of industry participants on a regular basis to ensure that the audit and inspections, and standards as well as other rules essential to the discharge of the Commission’s function as an independent quasi-judicial and quasi-legislative body are enforced.

WHEREAS, the Commission earnestly signifies its interest to be a member of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC) to help heighten and enhance the Commission’s capabilities to investigate and enforce its laws and procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as is hereby resolved that the Energy Regulatory Commission be included as regular member of the National Enforcement and Coordinating Committee (NALECC).
