RESOLUTION NO. 06 – 2003

**INCLUSION OF MINES AND GEO-SCIENCES BUREAU (MGB) AS A REGULAR
MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE
(NALECC)**

WHEREAS, the Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau (MGB), one of the primary government agencies created pursuant to Executive Order No. 192, Series of 1987, which is responsible for the development and exploitation of mineral resources and implementation of the Mining Act (Republic Act No. 7942) and the Treasure Hunting Law (Executive Order No. 35 and DAO 2002-04);

WHEREAS, the said agency is now a line Bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) pursuant to Republic Act No. 7942;

WHEREAS, to strengthen its commitment to conserve and protect the remaining mineral resources and cultural properties and other natural resources, the Sub-Committee on Environment and Natural Resources (SCENR) recommended the inclusion of MGB as a regular member of NALECC through Sub-Committee Resolution No. 2003-01;

WHEREAS, the Bureau has signified its intention to be a member of NALECC to enhance the Bureau's capabilities and effectively carry out its mandate;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as is hereby resolved that the Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau be included as member of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC).
