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## RESOLUTION NO. 06 – 2005

### **INCLUSION OF THE ANTI-TERRORISM TASK FORCE (ATTF) AND THE NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATION COMMISSION (NTC) AS REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE (NALECC) AND THEIR FURTHER INCLUSION TO THE SUB-COMMITTEE ON ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING AND COMBATING THE FINANCING OF TERRORISM (SCAML/CFT)**

**WHEREAS**, the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC) was created pursuant to Executive Order No. 41, as amended, to ensure a unified direction and integration of efforts by all enforcement agencies of the government involved in the enforcement of general and special laws;;

**WHEREAS**, the Sub-Committee on Anti-Money Laundering and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (SCAML/CFT) is one of the functional sub-committees of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC);

**WHEREAS**, the Anti-Terrorism Task Force (ATTF) of the National Security Council (NSC) as had been reconstituted with the Executive Secretary as Chair, and the National Security Adviser (NSA) as Vice Chairman, and composed of agencies under their respective supervision involved in counter-terrorism tasks as mandated under previous issuances shall have, among others, the following powers and functions:

- a) Formulate strategies, policies, plans and measures necessary to prevent and suppress acts of terrorism;
- b) Supervise and coordinate the implementation of government policies, plans and measures to prevent and suppress acts of terrorism;
- c) Coordinate with the ASEAN and other nations to promote the sharing intelligence in the campaign against terrorism;
- d) Call upon departments/agencies/bureaus/task forces/and other offices/bodies of government for such assistance as may be necessary in the performance of its mandate;
- e) Tap government and former government officials, private individuals/corporations and other stakeholders to participate in the activities of the ATTF either as resource persons or special advisers; and
- f) Perform such other functions as may be directed by the President.

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**WHEREAS**, the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC), an attached agency of the Department of Transportation and Communication (DOTC), has jurisdiction, control, and supervision over telecommunications, broadcasts, and CATV industry and services, and the radio spectrum;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for all concerned government agencies for close coordination and collaboration efforts to effectively address money laundering and terrorism in the country;

**WHEREAS**, during the 120<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting held at the PNP Main Conference Room, National Headquarters Building, Camp Crame, Quezon City on March 31, 2005, the Body unanimously approved the recommendations of the Sub-Committee on Anti-Money Laundering and Combating the Financing of Terrorism to include ATTF and NTC as regular members of NALECC and SACML/SCF;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Anti-Terrorism Task Force (ATTF) and the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) be included as a regular member of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC).

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that ATTF and NTC be regular members of the Sub-Committee on Anti-Money Laundering and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (SCAML/CFT).
