**WHEREAS**, during the said meeting, Mr. Rowell Samson, DOT representative made a motion to include the POEA as a member of the Sub-Committee on Interpol;

**WHEREAS**, such membership will facilitate lateral coordination between POEA and the SCI member-agencies, particularly the Interpol National Central Bureau Secretariat;

**WHEREAS**, the PCTC, through its Interpol National Central Bureau (NCB) Secretariat, has the I-24/7 Communication System that is connected with other Interpol member countries;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee has expressed its desire to facilitate the prevention of illegal recruitment and trafficking of persons and the investigation and prosecution of persons involved;

**WHEREAS**, during the 125<sup>th</sup> NALECC Regular Meeting and 23<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary held at the CAP John Hay Trade and Cultural Center, Camp John Hay, Baguio City, the Body unanimously approved the recommendation of the Sub-Committee on Interpol Matters (SCIM);
