RESOLUTION NO. 03 – 2007

INCLUSION OF THE AIR TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (ATO) AS A REGULAR MEMBER OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE ON FIREARMS, AMMUNITIONS AND EXPLOSIVE CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee on Firearms, Ammunition and Explosives Control (SCFAEC) is one of the functional sub-committees of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32, Chapter V of Republic Act No. 776 as amended by EO 564, ATO is charged to administer, operate, manage, control, maintain, and develop all government-owned airport, heliports, except those controlled and operated by the AFP;

WHEREAS, during the 50th NALECC-SCFAEC meeting it was moved that ATO be included as a member of the Sub-Committee on Firearms, Ammunition and Explosive Control;

WHEREAS, during the 130th NALECC Regular Meeting the SCFAEC presented to the Body the corresponding Resolution;

WHEREAS, there is a need to intensify Law enforcement efforts amid reports that criminal is smuggling illegal firearms through air transportations and current threat posted by both local and international terrorists:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved that the Air Transportation Office (ATO) be included as member of the NALECC Sub-Committee on Dangerous Drugs and Controlled Chemicals.
