**RENAMING OF THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE
SUB-COMMITTEE ON INTERPOL MATTERS (NALECC-SCIM)
FROM “SUB-COMMITTEE ON INTERPOL MATTERS”
TO “SUB-COMMITTEE ON INTERNATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COOPERATION” (SCILEC)**

WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee on Interpol Matters is one of the functional sub-committees of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Center (NALECC) created pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 92 dated 15 February 1993 to monitor Interpol Manila’s activities and to resolve any conflict that may arise with any government agency in providing international police cooperation services through the Interpol organization;

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WHEREAS, during the meeting of NALECC Sub-Committee On Interpol Matters held at the PDEA Main Conference Room, 2nd Floor PDEA Bldg., National Government Center, PInyahan, Quezon City on June 6, 2007 recommending to Mother NALECC for the renaming of NALECC Sub-Committee On Interpol Matters (NALECC-SCIM) To “Sub-Committee on International Law Enforcement Cooperation (SCILEC)

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved that the NALECC Sub-Committee On Interpol Matter be renamed as “Sub-Committee on International Law Enforcement Cooperation (**SCILEC**)
