RESOLUTION NR. 03-2010

INCLUSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) AND THE COMMISSION ON FILIPINOS OVERSEAS (CFO) AS REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE NALECC

WHEREAS, the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC) was created by virtue of Executive Order Nr. 829 as amended by Executive Orders Nr. 41 and 41-A;

WHEREAS, the NALECC is composed of fifty seven (57) regular member agencies with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) as the newest regular member effective June 27, 2008;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) is responsible in giving accreditation to medical clinics where Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) are referred for medical consultation and may require the accredited medical clinics to submit a database of applicants for overseas employment while the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) is designated as the lead agency on the Task Force against Human Trafficking;

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2007 and 27, 2009, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) and the Department of Health (DOH) respectively, submitted their Letters of Intent to join the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment (SCIR) of the National Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (NALECC);

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2010, members of the NALECC Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment (SCIR) unanimously approved Resolutions Nr. 01-2010 and 02-2010, recommending the inclusion of the Department of Health (DOH) and the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) as members of the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment (SCIR);

WHEREAS, during the 138th NALECC Regular Meeting, ATTY JONE B FUNG, Director II, Anti-Illegal Recruitment Branch of the Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA)/Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment (SCIR) presented and endorsed the Department of Health (DOH) and the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) to be included as regular members of the NALECC to address the illegal recruitment problems;

WHEREAS, before any government agency can be considered for membership of the Sub-Committee on Illegal Recruitment (SCIR), said agency must first become a regular member of the NALECC; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Department of Health (DOH) and the Commission of Filipinos Overseas (CFO) be included as regular members of the NALECC.
